

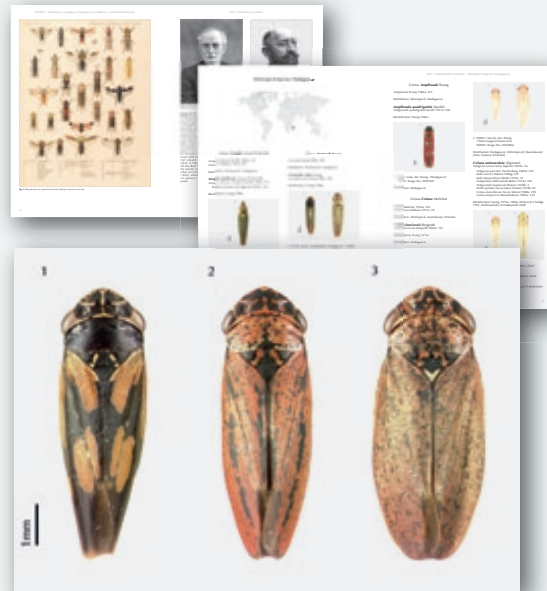
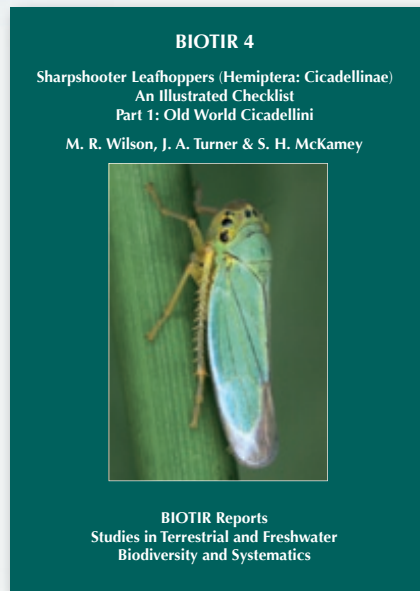

Funded by The Leverhulme Trust, *Sharpshooter Leafhoppers (Hemiptera:Cicadellidae: Cicadellinae) An Illustrated Checklist Part 1: Old World Cicadellini* is the first of three volumes that provide an illustrated checklist to the colourful insects of the subfamily Cicadellinae. This first volume includes an introduction to the Cicadellinae and their study, and an illustrated checklist of Old World species.



Following David Allan Young's monograph (1986) and Stuart H. McKamey's catalogue (2007), the illustrated checklist provides images of as many species as were available (over 90%), including type material. All synonymy is included, as are currently known distributions. A full bibliography is also provided.

For ease of use the species have been divided into sections relating to geographical regions in the Old World :

Afrotropical Species: Africa
Afrotropical Species: Madagascar
Asian Species (incl. East Palaearctic species)

New Guinea Species
Australasian and Pacific Species
